He is the President and CEO of the Global AIDS Interfaith Alliance (GAIA), a non-profit non-governmental organization described below. Prior to founding GAIA, he was Vice President, the United Religions Initiative, and President, Dean, and Professor of Christian Ethics at Episcopal Divinity School in Cambridge, Massachusetts. A priest in the Episcopal Church, Bill has been the rector of St. Stephen's, Belvedere, chaplain at the California Institute of Technology, and has served on hospital ethics, and research and human experimentation committees in Pasadena, Glendale, Greenbrae, and San Francisco, CA. He has served on the boards of many organizations, and has authored three books and many articles.



GAIA is a non-profit non-governmental organization that partners with religious organizations in resource-poor countries for community-based HIV prevention and care. By focusing on a grass-roots strategy to reach isolated village and the poorest of the poor, GAIA has been able to prevent and treat HIV for thousands of people in Malawi.
